REVISED POLICY ON ANNUAL RABIES VACCINATION WAIVER

RESOLVED that the American Veterinary Medical Association (AVMA) House of Delegates adopt the revised policy on Annual Rabies Vaccination Waiver as noted in the <u>attachment</u> (additions are <u>underlined</u>, deletions are <u>struck through</u>).

Statement about the Resolution

The Council on Public Health reviewed the policy on Annual Rabies Vaccination Waiver. Suggested revisions are to:

- Streamline and restructure language to improve clarity.
- Support communication to clients that if rabies vaccination is waived, the animal is at risk of rabies infection if a confirmed or suspected exposure occurs.
- Convey that under certain conditions of rabies exposure, if a client has chosen to waive a
 rabies vaccine, euthanasia may be included in recommendations or required under certain
 public health regulations.
