One Health Project 2012-2013

- 16 SUBMISSIONS FOR START-UP FUNDING REQUESTS (\$700 x 14 = \$9,800)
 - TWO SCHOOLS NEVER RECEIVED THEIR FUNDING DUE TO ADMINISTRATIVE ERRORS
- 4 SUBMISSIONS GRANT APPLICATIONS WERE SELECTED (\$1000 x 3 = \$3000)
 - KANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY, THE OHIO STATE UNIVERSITY, UNIVERSITY OF PENNSYLVANIA
 - AN ADDITIONAL COMPETITIVE GRANT WAS RETURNED TO SAVMA BECAUSE THE CHECK ARRIVED TOO LATE FOR EVENT PLANNING AND EXECUTION
- CURRENT TOTAL = \$12,800
- RECEIVED ALMOST ALL EVENT REPORTS FROM ALL SCHOOLS

APPLICATION DEADLINES:

-- Start-up fund applications are accepted on a continuous basis. Each school is eligible for \$700 once annually. To check your school's eligibility, visit: http://bit.ly/SAVMAonehealthfundingavailability.

 - AMOUNT OF MONEY RAISED FOR NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS = \$7,651








